

Rock Bugs or Dough Bugs!!



For Rock Bugs you will need:

Some flat or bug shaped pebbles
 (you might struggle to find one worm-shaped!)
 Sharpie or other permanent pens, acrylic
 Paints or paint + varnish!

What to do:

1. Clean and dry your pebbles.
2. Draw on the design of your bug in pencil – accurately from a picture or from your own imagination. You can either make the whole pebble into the bug or have the picture of the bug on the pebble.
3. Carefully colour or paint on the colours
4. Make a few to hide in the places they might live and challenge others to find them.



For Dough Bugs you will need:

A lump of playdough, salt dough, plasticine or damp mud
 Natural materials that you find on the ground

What to do:

1. Mould the dough into the body shape of your bug.
2. Use tiny twigs, seeds, stones, petals, leaves to add wings, legs, eyes, antennae, tongue and whatever else you think your minibeast needs to help it get around, feed and protect itself!
3. Find a place for your bug to live that is safe from predators!
